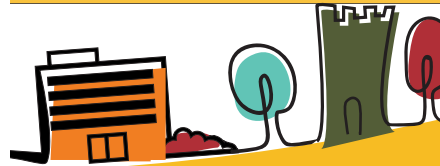

### Our school's education service

**Heritage Lincolnshire delivers a programme of National Curriculum linked entertaining and engaging workshops, lessons, and clubs for budding young archaeologists and historians. From introducing key historical topics, to exploring further through practical and experimental archaeological activities, we give students the skills to understand and interpret the historic environment around them.**

We provide a range of services for schools and colleges across the historic county of Lincolnshire designed to bring local heritage to life. Members of our Community Heritage Team visit schools across the county as part of our education and outreach work, offering curriculum linked sessions on any aspect of Lincolnshire's rich history.

We offer National Curriculum linked education workshops and can provide after school archaeology clubs. Our DBS checked staff are experienced in interacting

with and teaching pupils of all ages in all environments; inside or out! We are confident that we can provide enriching education experiences within your school setting, or as part of an arranged visit to the local area accessible on foot from the school.

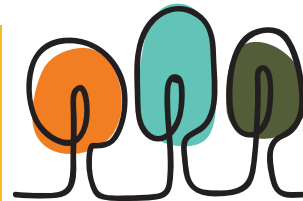
For classroom visits, we use object-based learning, so pupils will have the chance to handle real artefacts and discover history first-hand. By contrast, our 'exploration' field trips use evidence drawn from the local environment to tell the story of your village or town and the people who lived there.
