Where:	Bolingbroke Castle, Old Bolingbroke, Spilsby, Lincolnshire, PE23 4HH
When:	12 th or 13 th August 2023. 9.30am-5pm. Volunteers are expected to support on one of the event days and have the opportunity to attend the event for free on the other day.
Why Bolingbroke Back in Time needs volunteer support:	This is the third year Heritage Lincolnshire (HTL) and Friends of Bolingbroke Castle (FOBC) are running Bolingbroke Back in Time, a medieval reenactment festival for the whole family. We are looking for volunteer stewards to help make the event run smoothly. Roles on the ticketing desk, carpark, traffic management and general stewarding are available. In exchange, all volunteers will have free access to Bolingbroke
What to expect:	Back in Time on the other event day. HTL and FOBC will welcome you on site for a staff and volunteer briefing on site at 9.30am on either Saturday 12 th or Sunday 13 th August describing your duties and how the days will run. It is expected that volunteers will be rotated through different parts of the event throughout the day.
	These roles will require volunteers to be able to be on their feet for prolonged periods of time. A rest area for breaks will be available.
Notes:	Old Bolingbroke is not easily accesible by public transport, it is advisable that you travel by car to the event – parking will be provided.
