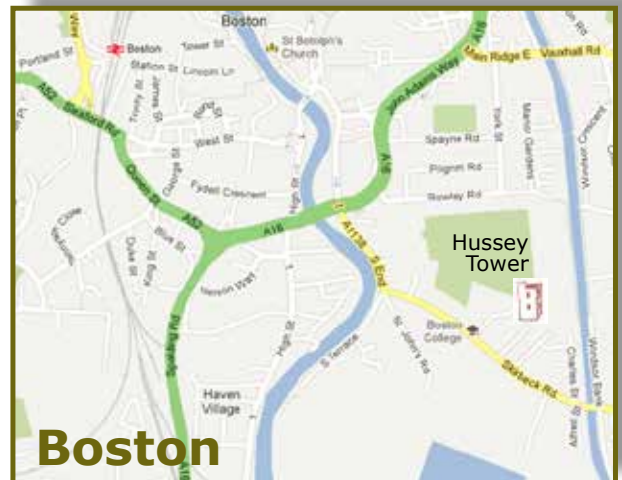




Visiting Hussey Tower

This section gives you information about planning a school visit to Hussey Tower. We can supply risk assessments if required.

Location: Hussey Tower is situated on Skirbeck Road, Boston near Boston College. There is a pedestrian entrance from Skirbeck Road



Opening hours: The site is open to the public every day all year round. The tower itself is open for special events and open days and by prior arrangement. We are very happy to welcome school visits. Just contact us to make arrangements.

Admission: No charge is made for normal admission to the site.

Facilities: There are no facilities at the site. Please contact us if this could cause problems for a school visit and we will do our best to provide a solution.

Access: The site is grassed and a gravel path leads to and around the outside of the tower. The inside floor of the tower is also a gravel surface. The spiral stair turret is open to visitors but people with mobility difficulties will find access to the stairs difficult.

Access for buses: School parties are advised to drop off at the entrance gate on Skirbeck Road and arrange parking elsewhere for a bus. Again, please contact us if you need help with this.

The tower is a Scheduled Monument. Metal detecting is not allowed.
